ZJX ARTCC Limited Enroute Configuration

Purpose

This document prescribes the procedures to be utilized for providing air traffic control services when limited enroute services are enacted. Limited enroute services can be initiated when high traffic volumes on the VATSIM network would degrade the quality of services provided to pilots in a top down environment. The procedures described herein are supplemental to the ZJX Enroute SOP, the Jacksonville ARTCC Facility Operating Guidelines and FAA Order JO 7110.65, as well as any published FAA guidelines or procedures.




- If four or more enroute controllers will be used OR a low center sector wishes to connect, controllers shall revert back to the ZJX Enroute SOP full configuration.
- Decombining in reverse order is also permitted.
- If at anytime the limited enroute configuration is active a new controller wishes to open JAX30, the limited enroute configuration shall be terminated and the controllers shall revert back to the standard enroute SOP.

Traffic Flow

Initial climbs and descents shall be referenced from the ZJX Enroute SOP.

Area of Coverage

Panhandle (JAX_P_CTR)



Panhandle manages top down services in the western and gulf portion of the airspace adjacent to ZHU, ZTL and ZMA. Panhandle encompasses the boundaries of sectors 30, 11, 34 and 17 on a top down basis. When active alone, Panhandle will accept initial handoffs from ZTL into low sectors 10(Crestview), 12(Albany) and 13(Ashburn). Aircraft can then be terminated if they will not remain inside Panhandle's airspace.



CENTRAL (JAX_C_CTR)



Central manages top down services in the central portion of the airspace adjacent to ZTL and ZMA. Central encompasses the boundaries of sectors 33, 78, 16, 50, 75 and 58 on a top down basis. When active alone, Central will accept initial handoffs from ZTL into low sectors 12(Albany),13(Ashburn),29(Waycross), 79(Baxly) and 73(Allendale) for SAV arrivals only. Aircraft can then be terminated if they will not remain inside Central's airspace.



Atlantic manages top down services in the NE and atlantic portion of the airspace adjacent to ZTL, ZDC, ZMA and ZWY. Atlantic encompasses the boundaries of sectors 66, 47, 52, 68 and 35 on a top down basis. When active alone, Atlantic will accept initial handoffs from ZTL into low sectors 73(Allendale), 72(Columbia) and 71(Florence). Aircraft can then be terminated if they will not remain inside Atlantic's airspace.
